



MAKE-YOUR-OWN MITTENS FROM AN OLD JUMPER

YOU WILL NEED:

- Old jumper
- Pen & paper
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Needle and thread



STEP 1. TRACE

Trace your hand on a piece of paper.



STEP 2. CUT THE PAPER

Measure a 1cm seam allowance outside the line you just drew and cut out the piece of paper.



STEP 3. CUT THE JUMPER

Line the piece of paper up on the bottom seam of your jumper. Cut around your paper template four times to create four individual pieces. Match up the thumbs and bases to create two gloves.



STEP 4. SEW

Sew the two cut outs together. Sew 1cm from the outer line. Complete the way around to the other side. Tie a knot at the bottom of stitching to secure.



STEP 5. INSIDE OUT

Turn it inside out and the first mitten is made. Complete instructions to make second mitten.
